

## CLASS XI A

### PROMOTION RULES FOR CLASS XI AS PER C.B.S.E. RULES

- It is mandatory for students to attend the school regularly.
- The students not found present, without valid reason, on the day of surprise inspection may not be able to appear in the examination.
- In order to declare pass, a student must secure 33% marks in each of the subjects.
- He secures 33% marks separately in Theory and Practical portion.
- A minimum of 25% marks should be secured in the Comprehensive Test (Annual).

### COMPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION

A student who has appeared in comprehensive examination but is not eligible for promotion to next class is eligible for appearing in the compartmental examination provided:

1. He has secured at least 20% marks in 1 failing subject i.e. (20 or more out of 100)

OR

In case the Candidate gets at least 15% of marks in one failing subject (i.e. cases where marks are  $\geq 15$  but  $< 20$ ) and 40% marks in aggregate in the remaining subjects, he is also eligible for appearing in compartmental examination.

2. For practical subjects, the rule is generally interpreted as follows:
  - a. If a student has failed in theory, compartment is given in theory only.
  - b. If a student has failed in practical, he has to appear both in theory and practical.
